- Subject to approval of the competent authority and fulfillment of all conditions MHRD shall release Rs ₹ 2,07,30,700/ (Rupees Two Crore Seven Lakhs Thirty Thousand and Seven Hundred Only) of the allocation as the first installment.
- The sanction is issued in exercise of the powers delegated to Ministries under DFPR, 1978, as amended from time to time. Above grants are being released in accordance with the pattern of Assistance approved by the Ministry of Finance, Governments of India. It is also certified that this Sanction is being issued in conformity with the rules and principles of the scheme.
